Consider starting with a 5-kilometer or 10-kilometer run to get a sense of what races are like, then set out for a full marathon when you have that solid base.

By narrower margins, more describe the use of computer algorithms by social media companies to find false information on their sites as a good rather than a bad idea for society (38 % to 31 %). (B), the public is far more hesitant about a future with the widespread use of computer chip implants in the brain to allow people to more quickly and accurately process information: 56 % say this would be a bad idea for society, whereas just 13 % think this would be a good idea.
